


Year 5 Topic Overview

Year 5 'Invaders and Settlers'



History

Our key topic driver this term is History.

The children will learn about the effects of the Anglo-Saxon and Viking settlement on Britain. They will use their knowledge of chronology to place these periods on a timeline and identify key events. They will use sources of evidence to interpret how history has documented the Saxons and Vikings. They will learn about life during these times and the legacy they have on Britain today.

Science

In science the children will learn about Earth and Space, learning about the major planets, how the earth moves and what causes night and day. They will then learn about forces in Autumn 2 where they will learn about the impact of forces on our everyday lives.

Religious Education

In RE, children will explore religion around the world and the similarities and differences in the world's major religions. They will reflect on their own beliefs and the part they play in society.

PSHE

This term the children will enjoy a special week dedicated to Anti- Bullying. The children will learn what bullying is as well as exploring how it can make people feel and what to do about it. Alongside this week they will look at specific character traits weekly to make them better learners.

Design and Technology

In design and technology, the children will build on their knowledge of sewing to design and make a pillowcase for a particular audience. They will learn more stitches to use in their work.

Music

This term in music, children will learn about singing and music appraisal.

Art

In art, children explore a range of different media, including sketching, colours through pastels and watercolors and sculpting with clay when designing and creating a dragons eye.

They will also explore textile art and use Saxon craft as a starting point for a batik textile piece of art.

Writing

Children will build on their writing skills from previously to write a journey narrative, a diary, a persuasive letter and a biography.

Reading

Children in year 5 will take part in whole class reading daily, where they will use a range of skills to comprehend aspects of a text. They will be exposed to longer novels, picture books, poems and non-fiction throughout the term. Some children will also practice fluency in guided sessions.

Maths

Please support your child to ensure they are fluent at all the times tables up to 12 x 12 and related division facts.

Reading

Please support your child to read independently or to an adult every day.

Wider curriculum

Ask your child what they have learnt each day. Talking about what they have learnt will help them remember it.

Writing

Support them to practice weekly spellings together.
