

# Year 6 Topic Overview

Summer Term 2023



# Core Subjects

## Maths

In Maths, children will be focusing on their application of all of the mathematical concepts taught across the year in order to apply these to a range of questions. Children will particularly revisit their four operations of Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, along with their knowledge of how to manipulate the above with fractions, rather than integers. They will continue to have daily practice of applying their reasoning to complex problems across areas such as shape and measurement.

## Writing

In writing, children will build on their writing experience by writing in a range of different genres such as, romance narrative, persuasive advert, and descriptive review.

## Reading

Children will participate in daily guided reading and children will be exposed to a range of texts covering all of the genres of fiction, non-fiction and poetry. Alongside this, children will also read the Core Text of Time Travelling with my Hamster by Ross Welford.



# Wider curriculum

## Art

The children will be researching the work of Beatriz Milhazes in order to employ her techniques to create their own collage.

## Geography

Children will explore the use of time zones and their position on a map. They will then explore how these work and why they were created.

## History

In history, the children will learn about the Ancient Greeks and will focus in particular on what life was like for people at this time, including how the landscape impacted their daily lives.

## Music

Children will focus on their performance this term, creating an all-singing, all-dancing end of Year 6 Leavers' Production!



# Wider curriculum



## DT

Children will research about the nutrition and cooking of sauces before they attempt to make their own!

## RE

Children will consider the ways in which faith and identify are often interlinked.

## Science

The children will be exploring the function of the circulatory system; the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the function of their bodies; and they will describe the way in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.

## PSHE

Children will focus on how they will change as they continue to grow, focusing on how their independence will develop, as will their relationships.

## Maths

- Continue to focus on quick recall of multiplication facts, including related division facts.
- Explore how knowledge of facts can enable us to answer much more complex calculations, including those with a variety of operations.

## Writing

Encourage independent writing opportunities – support your child to write for a range of purposes.

## Reading

Please read with your child at **least three times a week**. We ask that all books are to be returned every Friday to be changed.

## Wider curriculum

Ask your child what they have learnt each day. Talking about what they have learnt will help them remember it.
